

## **2011-2012 Show Requirements**

### **Soloists**

The soloist requirements for the following year's show start with the summer session. Skaters should talk with their private coach about their individual status. The requirements are:

1. Skaters must have passed either FS/4 or Open Silver by the show cutoff test
2. Skaters must book 2 hours of ice during the summer session
3. Skaters must book 3 hours of ice from September – June
4. Skaters must take lessons from a CAFSC coach
5. Skaters must be members in good standing with the club, with all financial obligations current
6. Skaters are encouraged to:
  - Volunteer 10 hours per year to the club
  - Represent CAFSC at a minimum of 2 competitions a year
  - Any combination of "a" and "b" above, volunteer 5 hours and represent CAFSC in 1 competition
7. Consideration will be given to high school seniors.

### **Duos / Trios**

The requirements for a duo or trio for the following year's show start with the summer session. Skaters should talk with their private coach about their individual status. The requirements are:

1. Skaters must have passed FS/3 by the show cutoff test
2. Skaters must book 1 hours of ice during the summer session
3. Skaters must book 2 hours of ice from September – June
4. Skaters must take lessons from a CAFSC coach
5. Skaters who qualify for a solo by level but do not meet the other requirements

Duo and trio assignments will be made by our coaching staff.

### **Advanced Number**

The advanced number requirements for the following year's show start with the summer session. Skaters should talk with their private coach about their individual status. The requirements are:

1. Soloists OR
2. Skaters that have passed FS/4 or Open Silver by the Show test date but did not meet the solo criteria  
OR
3. USFS skaters that have passed the Preliminary Freestyle test or higher.
4. Skaters must be members in good standing with the club, with all financial obligations current
5. Skaters must contract at least 1 session per week. Skaters must be signed up for the show and pay the costume deposit, show fee and the advance number fee.
